Derrick Choi, while with Earth Tech Architecture, served as the lead planner and project architect on the permitting and concept design phase of a new terminal facility to replace the Barnstable Municipal Airport's aging 1950's building. The proposed terminal development, developed in collaboration with Brown Lindquist Fenuccio and Raber Architects, as part of a larger US \$30 million airport redevelopment project, was successfully approved by the Cape Cod Commission in 2006.

Exceeding the Cape Cod Commission's sustainability recommendations - the new facilities will showcase the Airport Commission's commitment to environmentally-responsible design, utilizing natural clay-fired terra cotta exterior cladding, extensive use of an energy-efficient curtain wall system with operable louvers accommodating natural ventilation, and a radiant heating / cooling floor system.
