As part of the 2008 AIA National Convention in Boston, XChange participated in the Dudley Square Charette and Design Competition to reconceptualize a development parcel in Dudley Square at the heart of Roxbury.

In response to the competition brief to develop a mixed-use facility that addresses the urban design, community-building and sustainability challenges for the site, XChange proposed a new facility that not only provides a new nexus for the community - with performance spaces, recreational gardens and office/studio spaces - but offers a new public transportation solution to the current congestion at the T station by segregating the inbound and outbound bus traffic using a new station and waiting hall.

The proposal was a jury selection for a local exhibition in Hibernian Hall, Dudley Square.
