Ground has been broken on the Kollel of Greater Boston's Center for Talmudic Study in the Aberdeen District of Brighton, MA. The design of the new facility carefully responded to the Boston Redevelopment Authority's recommendations to harmonize with the prevailing brick language of the neighborhood and to reinvigorate a "storefront" ground-level commercial spirit to the area.

The 6,000 SF, two-story facility with a basement level will be the future home of the Kollel of Greater Boston. The brick, steel and glass building will provide office and meeting spaces on the second level, a library and sanctuary space on the street level, and a large community room with a landscaped terrace on the basement level.

The new 3-story facility is slated for completion in July 2009.
