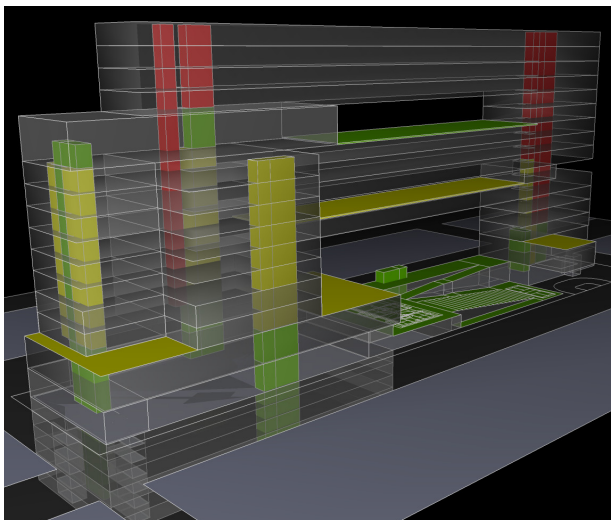


## VANCOUVER HIGH-RISE CONCEPT

The mixed-use development proposal/concept design for a typical lot in Downtown Vancouver, B.C. challenged the “podium-and-tower” developer model that has been prevalent over the last decade in the city.

By reorganizing public access in relation to various public and private building programs - retail, housing, offices, sports/recreation, and arts facilities - a unique, re-shuffled building was realized, providing a new way to reconnect the public and private realms in a single building type.

This project was exhibited in a 2007 symposium in the British Columbia Architecture Foundation in Vancouver, B.C.
