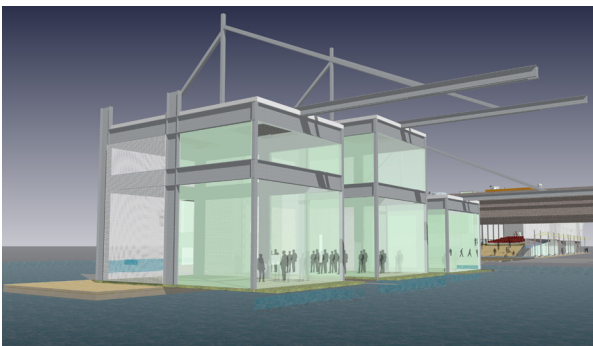

XChange's design concept for a new 30,000 SF home to the storied Seamen's Church Institute received a jury selection in the ENYA competition exhibition and publication in the Summer of 2008.

Sited in the South Street Seaport District in New York City, this proposal sought to recall the early days of ships docking in water slips in New York. Accordingly, the building's hull-like form and water features attempt to recall the maritime past of the district and propose a permanent dock for an organization known for its "Floating Church."
